COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$649 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 3.

The principal net increases were \$100 million in loans to other public utilities, \$67 million in communication loans, \$63 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor and tobacco, and \$171 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$59 million in loans for transportation.

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL TERM LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Total business loans were \$31,120 million as of April. This was a decrease of \$1,077 million over the comparable data a year ago and a decrease of \$129 million from the last Wednesday in March.

The principal net changes were \$25 million in loans for primary metals, \$20 million in loans for communication, \$42 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans, and \$102 million in all "other" types of business concerns.

The total of all business term loans on April 26 represented approximately 36 percent of business loans outstanding at large commercial banks reporting in the series.
