### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$130 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 10.

The principal net decreases were \$77 million in loans to other public utilities, \$55 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, and \$55 million in loans to manufacturers of other nondurable goods.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$52 million in manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather.
