COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$38 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 17.

The principal net increases were \$43 million in loans to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber, \$35 million in loans to retail trade and \$93 million in all other loans.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$77 million in total unclassified loans.
