### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$407 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 24.

The principal net increases were \$44 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans, and \$33 million in loans for construction.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$112 million in all other loans.
