COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$96 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 14.

The principal net increases were \$66 million in loans for retail trade, \$52 million in communication loans and \$83 million in unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$109 million for "all other" types of business concerns.
