### H.12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$582 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 28.

The principal net decreases were \$245 million in all other loans, \$122 million in loans to retail traders, and \$97 million in loans for mining.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$81 million in total unclassified loans.
