COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$279 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 9.

The principal net decreases were \$160 million in all other loans, \$98 million in loans to retail traders, and \$51 million in loans for transportation.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$172 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans.
