COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$214 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 16.

The principal net increases were \$74 million in loans for retail trade, \$63 million in loans for construction and \$61 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$ 92 million in all other loans.
