COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$61 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 23.

The principal net decreases were \$75 million in all other loans, \$61 million in bankers' acceptances, and \$37 million in loans for retail trade.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$71 million in loans for other public utilities.
