COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$520 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 20.

The principal net increases were \$111 million in total unclassified loans, \$105 million in loans for retail trade, and \$68 million in loans to manufactures of machinery.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$37 million in loans to manufactures of chemicals and rubber.
