COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$179 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 25.

The principal net decreases were \$89 million in loans to manufactures of machinery, \$57 million in loans to manufactures of textiles, apparel, and leather, and \$46 million in loans for construction.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$88 million in loans for retail trade.
