COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$35 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended November 22.

The principal net decreases were \$65 million in loans to manufactures of textiles, apparel and leather, \$38 million in loans to manufactures of other durable goods and \$48 million in total unclassified loans.

The principal net increases were \$73 million in manufactures of food, liquor, and tobacco and \$74 million in retail trade.
