COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$156 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended November 29.

The principal net increases were \$107 million in total unclassified loans, \$52 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans and \$39 million in loans for services.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$71 million in loans for retail trade.
