COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$1,319 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 20.

The principal net increases were \$159 million in total unclassified loans, \$152 million in loans for mining, and \$150 million in loans to manufactures of food, liquor and tobacco.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$21 million in loans for retail trade.
