

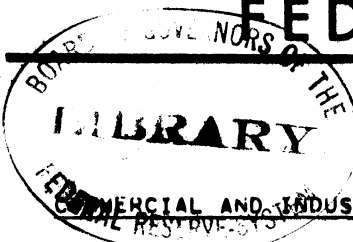

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$13 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended January 24.

The principal net increases were \$56 million in loans to manufactures of petroleum refining, \$45 million in loans for mining and \$29 million in loans for other wholesale trade.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$60 million in loans to manufactures of machinery.
