H.12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$781 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended January 31.

The principal net increases were \$103 million in total unclassified loans, \$92 million in all other loans and \$89 million in loans to manufactures of machinery.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$24 million in bankers' acceptances.
