COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$971 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 14.

The principal net increases were \$118 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$103 million in total unclassified loans and \$97 million in loans for services.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$25 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
