COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

For immediate release
March 28, 1973

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$1,155 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 21.

The principal net increases were \$287 million in total unclassified loans, \$154 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor and tobacco and \$153 million in loans to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$47 million in loans to commodity dealers.
