COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$218 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 28.

The principal net increases were \$221 million in total unclassified loans, \$86 million in loans for retail trade, and \$71 million in loans for services.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$122 million in loans to commodity dealers.
