COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$1,036 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 18.

The principal net increases were \$306 million in total unclassified loans, \$171 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery and \$107 million in loans for construction.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$78 million in loans for commodity dealers.
