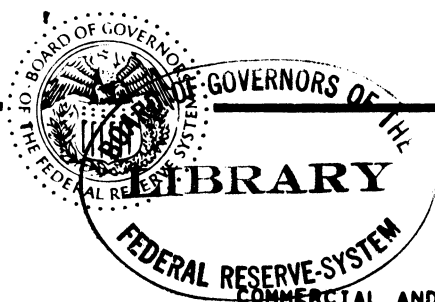

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$12 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 25.

The principal net decreases were \$64 million in loans to commodity dealers, \$60 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment, and \$47 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$111 million in loans for other public utilities.
