## COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$13 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 9.

The principal net decreases were \$126 million in loans for communication, \$65 million in total unclassified loans, and \$37 million in all other loans.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$76 million in bankers acceptances.
