### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$552 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 16.

The principal net increases were \$241 million in retail trade, \$138 million in total unclassified loans, and \$98 million in all other loans.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$60 million in loans for other wholesale trade.
