COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$134 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 30.

The principal net decrease were \$106 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$60 million in loans to commodity dealers and \$40 million in total unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$146 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
