COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$463 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 13.

The principal net increases were \$141 million in loans to manufactures of machinery, \$71 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$65 million in loans to manufacturers of other fabricated metal products, and \$65 million in loans to manufactures of other durable goods.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$61 million in loans to commodity dealers.
