COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$ 1,359 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 20.

The principal net increases were \$ 235 million in total unclassified loans, \$ 200 million in loans for other public utilities, and \$ 170 million in loans for mining.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$ 23 million in loans to commodity dealers.
