COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

For immediate release
July 25, 1973

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$236 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended July 18.

The principal net increases were \$177 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor and tobacco, \$77 million in loans for other public utilities, and \$72 million in loans for transportation.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$69 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
