COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

H.12

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$485 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 8.

The principal net changes were \$114 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$54 million in loans for bankers acceptances and \$52 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel and leather.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$71 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans.
