COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$268 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 22.

The principal net decreases were \$114 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$80 million in loans for retail trade and \$56 million in loans for mining.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$84 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans.
