COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$486 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 12.

The principal net increases were \$96 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$87 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans, and \$69 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$42 million in loans for petroleum refining.
