COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$203 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 10.

The principal net decreases were \$91 million in loans for construction, \$88 million in total unclassified loans and \$67 million in loans for other public utilities.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$78 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans.
