COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$328 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 17.

The principal net decreases were \$157 million in total unclassified loans, \$70 million in all other loans, and \$65 million in loans for communication.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$53 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
