COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

For immediate release
October 31, 1973

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$444 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 24.

The principal net decreases were \$196 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$91 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel and leather and \$58 million in loans to manufacturers of other durable goods.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$48 million in loans to retail trade.
