COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

For immediate release
November 7, 1973

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$292 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 31.

The principal net decreases were \$127 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$115 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, and \$73 million in loans for mining.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$152 million in loans to commodity dealers.
