COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$44 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended November 28.

The principal net increases were \$65 million in loans for services, \$56 million in total unclassified loans, and \$54 million in all other loans.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$58 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather.
