COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

H. 12

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$234 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 12.

The principal net increases were \$264 million in total unclassified loans, \$124 million in loans for construction and \$65 million in all other loans.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$159 million in loans for retail trade.
