### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$670 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 19.

The principal net increases were \$671 million in total classified loans, \$179 million in loans for services and \$143 million in both bankers acceptances and loans to manufacturers, of machinery.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$121 million in loans for construction.
