### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$47 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended January 16, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$129 million in other public utilities, \$109 million in total unclassified loans and \$101 million in services.

The largest offsetting increase was \$175 million in retail trade.
