### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$449 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended January 23, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$196 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$114 million in all other loans and \$108 million in total unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting increase was \$113 million in loans for commodity dealers.
