COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$184 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended January 30, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$196 million in loans for other public utilities, \$150 million in total classified loans and \$108 million in loans for retail trade.

The largest offsetting increase was \$114 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.
