COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$221 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended February 6, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$325 million in total classified loans, \$89 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment and \$83 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$104 million in total unclassified loans.

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL TERM LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Total commercial and industrial term loans were \$41,489 million as of January. This was an increase of \$6,544 million over the comparable data a year ago and an increase of \$628 million from the last Wednesday in December.

The principal net changes were \$160 million in loans for mining, \$133 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans and \$115 million in loans to services.

The total of all business term loans on January 30 represents 45 per cent of business outstanding at large commercial banks in the series.
