### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$175 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended February 13, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$150 million in loans for retail trade, \$89 million in total unclassified loans and \$88 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$161 million in loans for other public utilities.
