COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$9 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended February 20, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$78 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment, \$75 million in loans to manufacturers of textile, apparel, and leather and \$72 million in loans to manufacturers of other durable goods.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$118 million in all other loans.
