COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

H.12

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$900 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 13, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$788 million in total classified loans, \$150 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery and \$112 million in total unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$53 million in loans for retail trade.
