COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$2,013 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 20, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$1,634 million in total classified loans, \$379 million in total unclassified loans and \$210 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$54 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
