H.12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

For immediate release
April 17, 1974

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$350 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 10, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$131 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$109 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather and \$97 million in loans to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$145 million in loans for petroleum refining.
