### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$1,506 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 17, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$459 million in total unclassified loans, \$191 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery and \$143 million in loans for retail trade.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$120 million in loans for commodity dealers.
