COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$593 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 24, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$258 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$105 million in loans to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber and \$104 million in loans for retail trade.

The largest offsetting increase was \$99 million in total unclassified loans.
