COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$12 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 8, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$150 million in loans for retail trade, \$134 million in loans for commodity dealers and \$125 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.

The largest offsetting increase was \$100 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment.
