### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$59 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 15, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$105 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$66 million in loans to manufacturers of other fabricated metal products and \$58 million in loans for mining.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$134 million in all other loans.
